The RCS Home Care Program helps adults 60 and older in Randolph County remain safely at home by providing personal care and homemaker services. Care is delivered by trained staff under the supervision of a registered nurse. Private pay is accepted. Eligibility requires a functional disability and a completed needs assessment.

In Home Assistance

- Planning nutritious meals
- Food Prep
- Basic personal care (bathing, shaving, hair grooming, etc)
- Household duties (light housekeeping, washing dishes, vacuuming etc.)
- Toileting
- Positioning/Turning
- Assistance with feeding
- Assistance with ADL's
- Range of motion
- Laundry
- Nail care for non-diabetic clients
- Respite for caregivers

Routine Services

- Minor plumbing repairs
- Minor electrical repairs
- Installation of locks and other security features
- Home modifications (wheelchair ramps, hand rails, grab bars, hoist lifts, etc.)
